

SEYMOUR & DISTRICT ART SOCIETY INC

AMENDED BY LAWS FEBRUARY 2018

1. **A Sub-Committee of three**, including the treasurer be appointed each year to review the financial situation of the Society. Findings should be reported to the “Committee” of the Art Society in June, in order that all fees may be set at The Annual Meeting.
2. **Only financial Art Society** members may exhibit in the main Gallery. Works must be for sale and priced no lower than \$100.
 - a. A work displayed for a full exhibition may not be left in for the subsequent hanging.
 - b. Only financial members may exhibit in the Charles August Gallery. No hanging fee applies. Any work under \$100 attracts commission of 10%. Over \$100, the commission fee is increased to 15%. Some works can be for display only. Works exhibited in the Small Treasures Exhibition (November) must not be priced over \$100.
3. **Life Membership, Criteria:**
 - To have served on the Committee
 - To have made a significant contribution to the Society
 - To have been a member for at least ten years

When a member is nominated, the Committee shall discuss and make the decision to refer to Life Membership, and as such being exempt from paying annual membership fees.

4. **Appointment of Office Bearers:**
 - a. Committee to include an Assistant Secretary
 - b. Membership Secretary to be elected at Annual Meeting, who does not necessarily have to be a Committee Member.
5. **Permanent Collection: Criteria:**

Art work purchased must be something that complements our collection. Any new pieces purchased may only be considered for purchase when funds permit.
6. **Bus Trips, Workshops, Demonstrations etc.**

Fees must be set to cover ALL associated costs. Payment required when booking, and is non refundable.
